CPRE Cheshire invite you to our annual Christmas Celebration at a new venue - St Mary's Church in Rostherne, near Knutsford.

St Mary's Church lies between the village of Rostherne and Rostherne Mere and is recorded in the National Heritage List for England as a designated Grade I listed building. The church has many interesting features including the freestanding memorial to Charlotte Lucy Beatrix Egerton who drowned in Rostherne Mere on the eve of her wedding in 1845. It is by Richard Westmacott Jr. and depicts Charlotte lying on her side with an angel stooping over her.

Following the service and refreshments, our chaplain, Rev. John Whitehead, will give a guided tour of the church for those interested in learning more of its historical connections.
